New Mass Time starting Sept 5

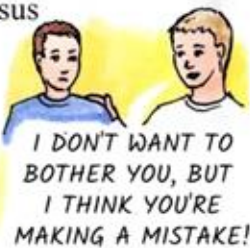
This is a reminder that St. Peter's will be holding weekend mass on Saturdays starting September 5th at 5:00pm
